

St. Paul's Catholic School Uniforms for Boys

Mass Dress Uniforms - Thursdays (all-school Mass):

- All grades: Long or short-sleeve white button-up dress shirt- must be tucked in.
- Grades PK 5th Grade: Navy pants and a school plaid ("MacEwen Modern" plaid) or navy-blue tie or bowtie.
- Grades 6th-8th: Khaki pants, navy blue or plaid tie or bowtie.



Uniforms on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays:

• Franciscan Community (PK - K):

Long or short sleeve red polo shirt and navy-blue uniform bottoms.



• Benedictine Community (Grades 1st - 5th):

Long or short sleeve light blue polo and navy-blue uniform bottoms.



• Ignatian Community (Grades 6th-8th):

Long or short sleeve navy blue polo shirt and khaki uniform bottoms.



SPIRIT DAYS:

On Fridays, students will be allowed to wear a spirit shirt with nice jeans or uniform pants. Jeans must be without holes, frays, or patches and they cannot be ill-fitting or skinny jeans. Spirit shirts are considered St. Paul's, Bishop Kelly, youth group, TVCS, or other diocesan organizations.

NOTES:

- Shirts are to be tucked in while inside all buildings during the school day.
- Hooded sweatshirts are not allowed in Mass.
- All sweatshirts and sweaters worn over the uniform shirt must be navy blue.
- Uniforms can be purchased at online retailers such as FrenchToast.com or Amazon, and in stores such as Walmart, Target, etc.
- •Shorts may not be worn between Thanksgiving Break and Spring Break
