



St. Paul's Routes for 2022-2023 School Year

1st Stop- Winco, Meridian (chinden and Linder) – . Bus will approximately arrive 6:50am and depart at 7:00a. Drop off at approximately 3:30pm and depart after five minutes.

2nd Stop- Caldwell pick up is at Luby Park – 416 N. Illinois Ave off exit 28. Bus will approximately arrive at 7:25am and depart at 7:30am. Drop off at approximately at 4:00pm and depart at 4:10pm

- The school bus will depart from school premises at 3:10pm
- Any students not picked up at the bus stop will be returned to St. Paul's School and will be at Backpack. Parent's will need to pick up at the Backpack program with an additional fee. Please indicate emergency pickUp on page 2.

All riders must be registered passenger in order to ride the bus.

There is no bus application fee required at the time of registration.

BUS FEE is \$175.00 per quarter (per student) billed to your tuition statement at the end of each quarter. Seats are available: first come, first served.

The school bus arrives at St. Paul's Catholic School in Nampa between 7:45am-8:00am on all school days.

Departure time is approximately 10-15 minutes after dismissal.

St. Paul's School Bus Safety Rules

The safety of our students is of primary importance. Please read the school Bus Rules and go over them with your child(ren). Parents, it will be your responsibility to make sure the child(ren) arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes prior to departure. We will be on a tight schedule and will be unable to wait for late arrivals. If your child(ren) will not be riding in the afternoon, please contact the school office during normal school hours. For afternoon pick-up, we again ask that you be punctual. If the designated adult has not picked up your child at the bus stop, the child **will remain on the bus** and be transported back to the school for you to pick them up here.



- Children should never enter the DANGER ZONE unless the driver has given them permission.
- If a child can touch the bus, he or she is too close.

A very important part of our school bus safety is the role parents share in reinforcing school bus safety. The following safety procedures should be reviewed with your children several times throughout the school year. The safe transportation of our children to and from school concerns all of us.

1. Arrive at the school bus pick up sight at least 5 minutes before the bus is scheduled to depart.
2. When waiting, please stay together with a designated parent away from traffic. Do not leave your child at the bus stop unattended. Wait for the bus to arrive before you leave the stop.
3. When the bus arrives please form a single file line and board the bus using the handrail.
4. One passenger per seat. Two siblings may sit together. Once on the bus, find your seat and stay seated until the bus arrives at school or the designated bus stop.
5. Aisles are to be kept clear at all times. Books, bags etc. should be stored under the seat.
6. Hands, feet, arms, and head should be kept inside the bus at all times.
7. There will be no eating or drinking on the bus.
8. Remain seated until the bus stops and the bus driver releases you to a designated adult.
9. Gather all belongings and exit in an orderly manner forming a single file line and using the handrail. Wait your turn until the others in front of you have exited – no crowding, pushing, etc.
10. If you get off the bus at a stop other than a parking lot, make sure the driver sees you before crossing in front of the bus, take 10 giant steps first! (see Danger Zones)

Students riding the bus are representing St. Paul's Catholic School and are expected to conduct themselves in the same manner as at school. They will be subject to the same disciplinary procedures that apply at school. The bus driver has the right to discipline students according to school guidelines and will write up students not following the rules. Parents should remind students of proper bus behavior in order to ensure the safety of the driver and the other students riding the bus. Thank you for your cooperation. Please contact the school office with any questions.

I have read and agree to follow the Bus Rules including NO BULLYING, CURSING, FOOD, CHEWING GUM, ELECTRONICS, PUSHING/SHOVING, JUMPING/CLIMBING ON SEATS, LOUD VOICES and I will STAY SEATED AND UPRIGHT IN MY SEAT AT ALL TIMES AND KEEP MY HANDS AND MY FEET TO MYSELF AND INSIDE THE BUS. Cell phones may only be used in case of emergency. I understand that riding the bus is a privilege and my ridership depends on the way I conduct myself every time I ride St. Paul's School bus.
